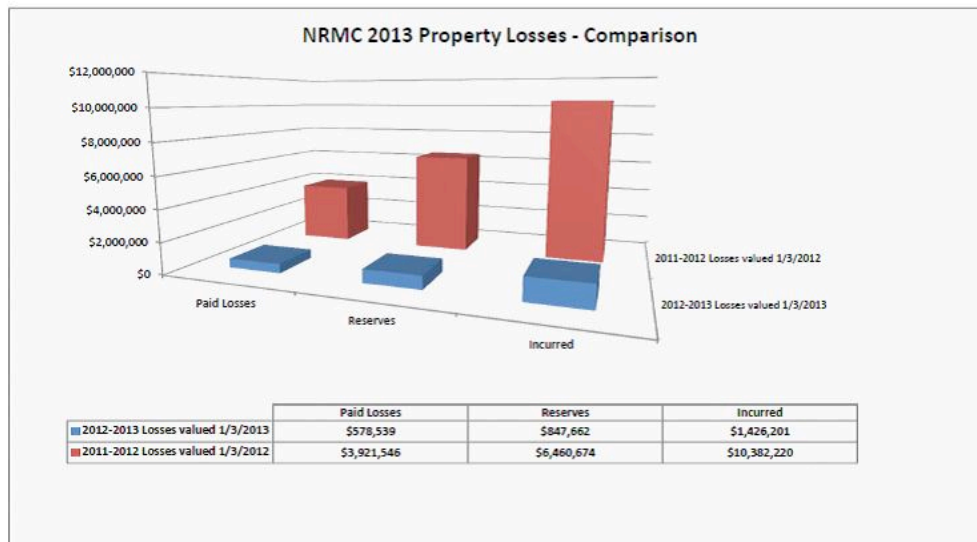

NRMC's Performance through the Third Quarter of Policy Year 2012 continues to show Excellent Performance and Continued Strength

NRMC's performance through the third quarter of policy year 2013 (4/1/12 to 12/31/12) continues to show excellent performance, with significantly fewer and lower losses for the same period in 2012, especially for the Property program. (See the chart below.) If this trend continues, our members can expect that this will have a favorable impact on next year's renewal and the possibility of a return of unused retention funds. The insurance carriers have taken note of this, and we anticipate receiving favorable initial quotes from them within the next two weeks.
